

ARTICLE 17
UNIT MEMBER EXPENSES AND MATERIALS

17.1 Tools

District agrees to provide all tools, equipment and supplies necessary to bargaining unit members for performance of employment duties.

17.2 Safety Equipment

Should the employment duties of an unit member in the bargaining unit require use of any supplies, equipment or gear to ensure the safety of the unit member or others, the District agrees to furnish such safety equipment.

17.3 Physical Examinations

The District shall provide the full cost of any medical examination required as a condition of employment or continued employment.

17.4 Fingerprinting

16.4.1 All classified unit members, except substitute and temporary unit members, shall have a full set of fingerprints on file with the Bureau of Criminal Identification and Investigation.

16.4.2 The District will reimburse unit members for the cost of fingerprinting.

17.5 Mileage

17.5.1 The Governing Board shall reimburse unit members at the IRS approved mileage rate for the use of their automobiles when they are on District business which shall include same day between site travel. The mileage for same day between site travel will only be granted when the District is the moving party to the unit member's assignment.

17.5.2 Unit members shall not be required to use privately-owned vehicles to conduct District business or personal business for other District personnel during the unit member's duty hours except when the safety of others is involved.

17.5.3 Unit members shall submit reimbursement for mileage and claims shall be paid in December and June for the preceding months. Claims for out-of-pocket expenses can be submitted at any time.
