Facilities Committee

The Piner-Olivet Union School District is forming a Facilities Committee to gather input regarding concerns about district facilities. The input will be used by the Board of Trustees to plan for future building projects in the District.

Here are some examples of the kinds of things a Facilities Committee might look at:

- Is a multi-purpose rooms too small?
- Is a cafeteria outdated?
- Is access to school playgrounds an issue?
- How is the condition of the bathrooms?
- Is there adequate parking?

The Committee will be working with a consultant, an architect and the District Superintendent to determine facilities needs in the District.

The Committee will be composed of the following members:

- 3 – 4 district parents/community members
- 2 – 3 community leaders (i.e., city council members, city staff)
- 1 – 2 school board members
- 2 – 3 district employees
- Other interested community members

The Committee will meet 3 – 5 times over the course of the school year.
