<b>Half Year – First Semester</b>	\$25.00	September 3, 2019
<b>Half Year – Second Semester</b>	\$25.00	January 7, 2020
<b>Full Year</b>	\$50.00	September 3, 2019

- Milk can only be purchased by half or full year
- Cost is the same, regardless if your child misses school due to illness or vacation
- Cost/Refund will be pro-rated for children who enroll late or leave the district

**PRE-PAYMENT OPTIONS:** Prepaid meal accounts help the lunch lines go faster and give students more time to eat, relax, and play. It also gives you the peace of mind of not having to worry about looking for lunch money every day or worry that it might get lost, stolen, or used for things other than lunch.

- We are not set up to accept payment on a daily basis and we ask that students **prepay for at least 5 lunches and/or breakfasts at a time.**
- **We are no longer accepting credit cards as a method of payment.**
- **Methods of Payment:**
  1. **Online (Preferred Method of Payment):** Online payments are simple, safe, and a secure way to make payments to your student’s account 24 hours a day, at your convenience. Go to [www.myschoolbucks.com](http://www.myschoolbucks.com). Select “Register for a Free Account” and follow the simple and easy instructions.
  2. **Check:** Make payable to **PINER FOOD SERVICE (There will be a \$25.00 fee on all returned checks)**. Please include your child’s **first and last name** on the check.
  3. **Cash:** Please place it in an envelope marked clearly with your student’s name, teacher, and the amount.
